- (a) It is right to give our thanks and praise.
- It is right that we give you thanks, God. We join with all of your creation: sun and moon and stars; birds and plants and our pets; with our parents and grandparents and best friends and we say thank you.
- We thank you for all that you have created us to be! We are created in your image as a beloved part of your world. You make us every day and in so many ways to be optimistic, respectful, thankful, generous, creative, kind, curious, honest, brave people. When we try our best to be all these things the whole world sees how wonderful you are!
- We especially thank you for Jesus. He was created to be just like us! He showed us your love and he also taught us how to love one another like you love us. One way he showed us your love was having a meal with his friends. At that meal, he took bread and gave thanks. He broke it and gave it to his friends and said: Take this, my friends, and eat it. This is my body and it's given for you. Do this when you remember me. He also took a cup and gave it to his friends to share and said, take this, friends, and drink some of it. This cup is a new promise from God for you to let you know that your sins are forgiven. Whenever you share this drink, remember me.
- P And still today when we share bread and a cup, we remember not just that one time Jesus shared this meal, but that Jesus is here with us now and everywhere. And for that we are so thankful.
- P Our thanks we give to you, O God, along with our honor and respect and love and when we give that to you we join our voices and our hearts with all those who have come before us and with all your angels and say:
- Thank you, Amen.

White grape juice is available in pre-filled cups for those who cannot have alcoholized wine.


Receive the bread in your open palm and then hold your cup steady for the assisting minister.
